

# Knitting patterns

NEEDLES: Nr. 4

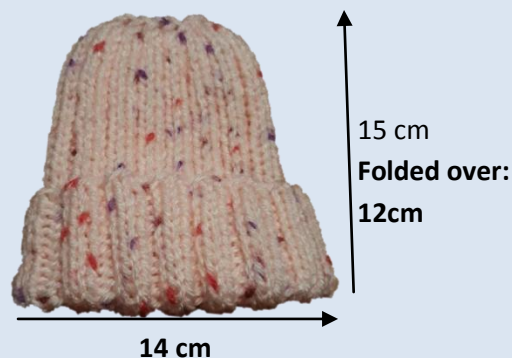
WOOL: Kartopu Benekli Bebe Baby Wool

It is not necessary to use this specific wool, it is just the wool used in the example.

Preferably, the wool should be soft and stretchy so that it does not irritate the baby's sensitive skin.

## **BEANIE:** the example is folded over at the bottom

1. Using a nr. 4 needle, cast on 62 stitches.
  2. Knit 2 plain and 2 purl for 38 rows.
  3. 39<sup>th</sup> row: knit 2 purl and each one of the two plain stitches two together until 36 stitches remain.
  4. Knit 1 row 1 plain 1 purl.
  5. Next row: knit 2 purl and each one of the 2 plain stitches 2 together - 18 stitches remain.
  6. Pull yarn through these 18 stitches to form a small wheel. sew wool and seam.
- When the beanie is done, it should measure 15cm high and 12 cm wide.
  - The bottom 3cm is folded over so that the beanie is shorter and wider- it is now 12cm in height and 14cm wide. The pattern can be stretched in order to fit different head sizes.



## SOCKS:

With 4mm needles, cast on 31 stitches.

1. Knit 6 rows in plain stitch.
2. Row 7: Knit 12 plain 2 together 3 plain 2 together 12 plain.
3. Row 8: Knit 11 plain 2 together 3 plain 2 together 11 plain.
4. Row 9: Knit 10 plain 2 together 3 plain 2 together 10 plain.
5. Row 10: Knit 9 plain 2 together 3 plain 2 together 9 plain.
6. Row 11: Knit 8 plain 2 together 3 plain 2 together 8 plain.
7. With 21 stitches remaining: Knit 14 rows 1 plain 1 purl.
8. Cast off loosely.
9. Sew seam at back and bottom.

The sock measures 8cm wide and 10cm high.
